Getting to the Grounds

Public Transport:

Halliday Park is conveniently located opposite the Bayswater Train Station and next to bus stops for bus lines 48, 998 and 999 (*seen blue icons on map*). Visit www.transperth.wa.gov.au for bus and train timetables.

Driving

If you are driving, there are limited parking facilities at the grounds. Ample parking is available at Mills Avenue Park (*see bottom left of map*). The drop off point for team buses is on Burnside Street, Bayswater.

Ground Facilities

Clubroom Facilities

Bayswater Lacrosse Club has a modern, two story club room with a balcony which overlooks Field 1. The clubrooms have kitchen, bar and AV facilities upstairs (with full disabled access) and a canteen downstairs. There are toilets available upstairs and downstairs (both wheelchair accessible).

Playing Surface

Bayswater Lacrosse Club has two playing fields at Halliday Park with Field 1 being lit to Australian Standards for night fixtures.

The fields are grass fields over sown with winter RYE grass and comply with the Australian Standards for field hardness. Refer to Appendix 1 for field dimensions.

Player Facilities

There are two change rooms with lockers which will be made available for team use for 45min pre match. Each change room has:

- 16 lockers (with some additional seating);
- 3 showers for player use; and
- 2 clean bins for ice baths***.

**** Please note, ice is to be supplied by user or pre-ordered. We can arrange ice to be available at the grounds for \$4.00 per 4kg bag however, pre orders are necessary. If you require ice for ice baths, and would like Bayswater Lacrosse Club to supply, please contact us by 15 September 2017 with your pre-order.*

Emergency first aid will be offered onsite and players will be able to access physiotherapy services on a user pays basis from a local physiotherapy center.

Nearby Amenities

There are many amenities in walking or short driving distance from the field. To name a few:

- Galleria Shopping Centre (shopping centre with full range of food and retail shops and cinema) - less than 5 min drive from grounds;
- Chemist – 2 min walk from grounds;
- IGA – 3 min walk from grounds;
- Bayswater Waves (recreational centre with 50m, heated (28°C) swimming pool, for recovery) – less than 5 min drive from grounds.

Cost of pool use is approximately \$4.70 per head (2 coaches free)

TOURNAMENT ARRANGEMENTS

Team Lunches & Dinners

Team lunches will be offered with a variety of menu options starting from \$8.00 per head. A menu and pricelist will be made available closer to the tournament.

Dinners will be available in our upstairs clubroom during some of the night games. Spectators will be able to enjoy something to eat while watching the games from our balcony.

Functions and events

Welcome Function – 1 October 2017

The welcome function will be held at Bayswater Lacrosse Club after the completion of the final game (approximately 7pm).

The cost of the function will be \$15 per head, which will include dinner.

Final Function – 7 October 2017

The final function will be held at Maylands Sport and Recreation (50 Clarkson Rd, Maylands) from 7pm. The cost of the function will be \$40 per head, which will include buffet meals, non-alcoholic drinks package and entertainment. There will be an allocation of 20 tickets per boys team and 20 tickets per girls team. Extra tickets will be available for purchase (please note, additional tickets must be pre-ordered).

Tournament Package

Fixtures

The fixtures have been drawn up according to ALA By-Laws. The first game each day will be commencing at 9am with the final game to commence at 5.45pm (night game). The match times have been scheduled to maximise attendance from spectators, and minimise the amount of time that players are required at the ground to watch all matches.

The fixtures will be released closer to the tournament, once team nomination have been received by the Australian Lacrosse Association.

Meetings for umpires, referees and coaches & managers will be held on the evening of Saturday, 30 September 2017 at Bayswater Lacrosse Club with times of meetings to be advised closer to the tournament date.

Listed below are a number of different accommodation options available for teams and spectators.

Broadwater Apartments Como - great spot on city edge and comes highly recommended. All apartments have full kitchens, living and dining areas plus internal laundries.
